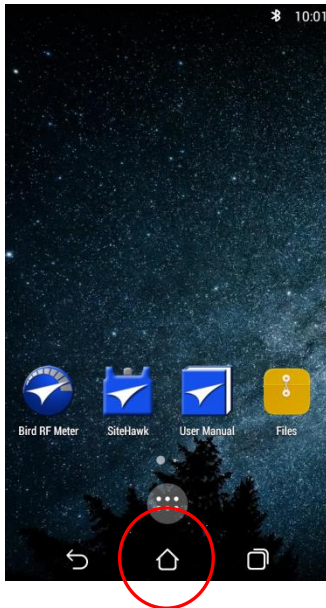
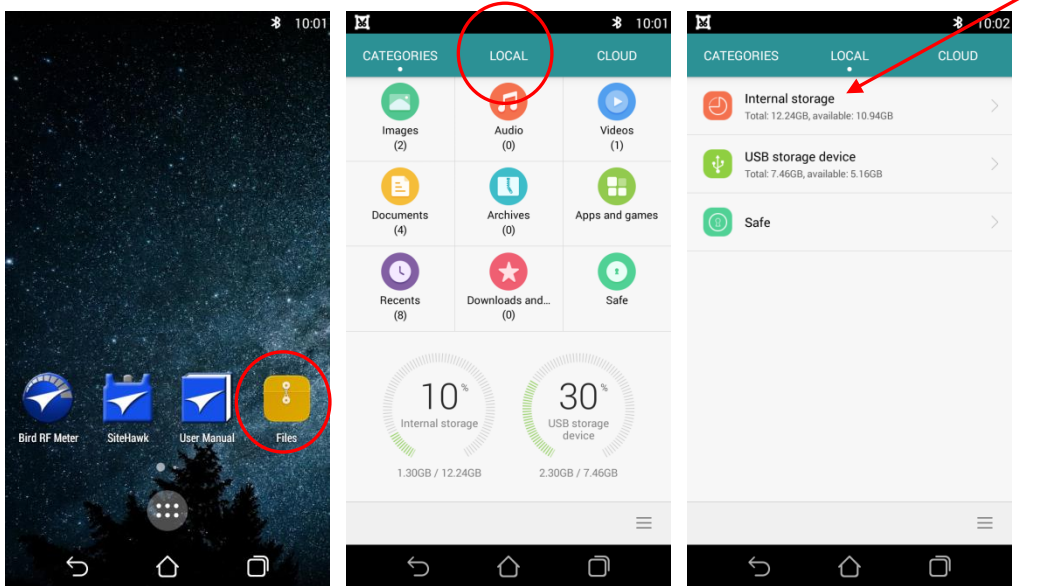


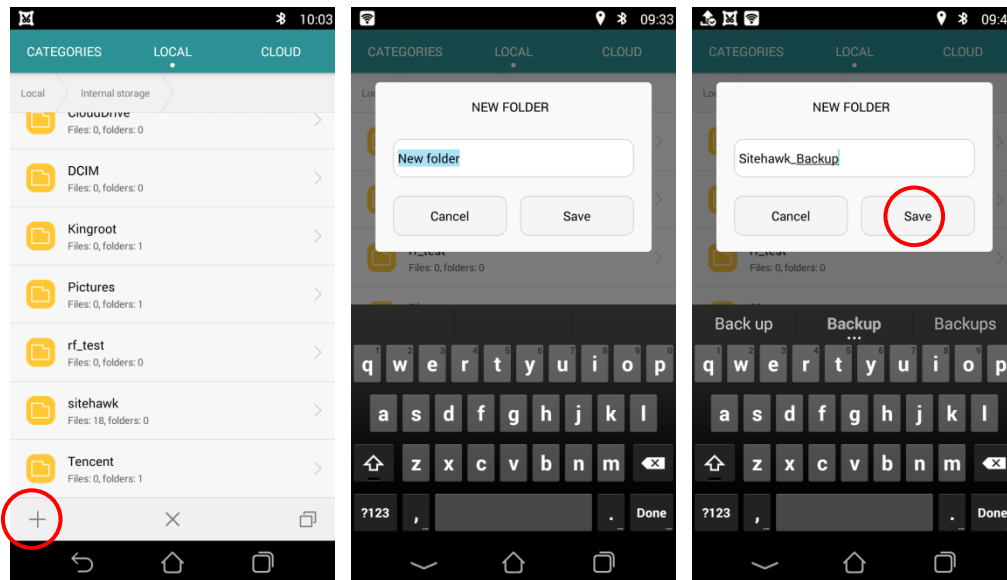
1. Navigate to main screen by pressing Home icon.



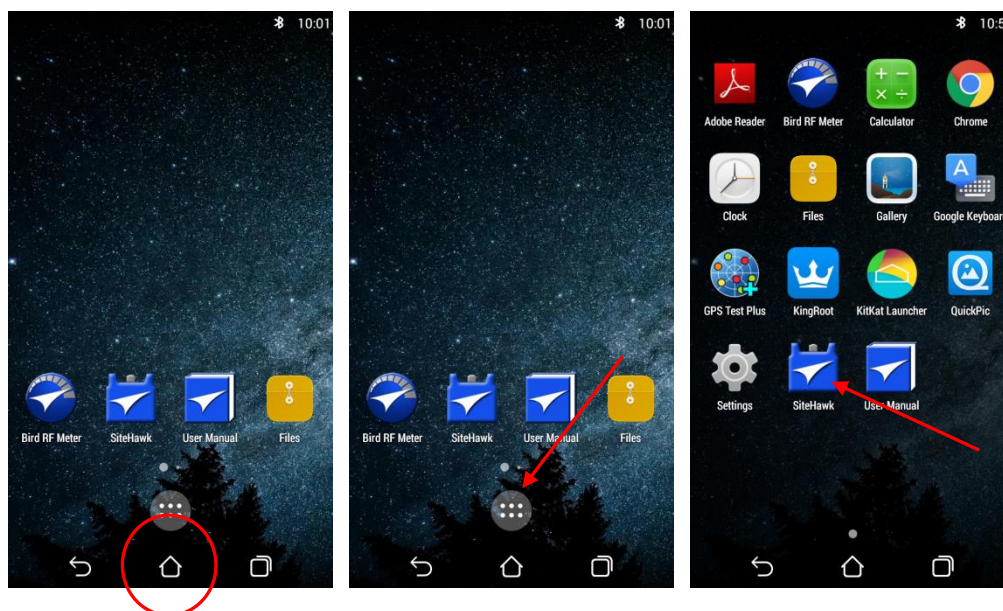
2. Press Files icon, select Local, select Internal storage.



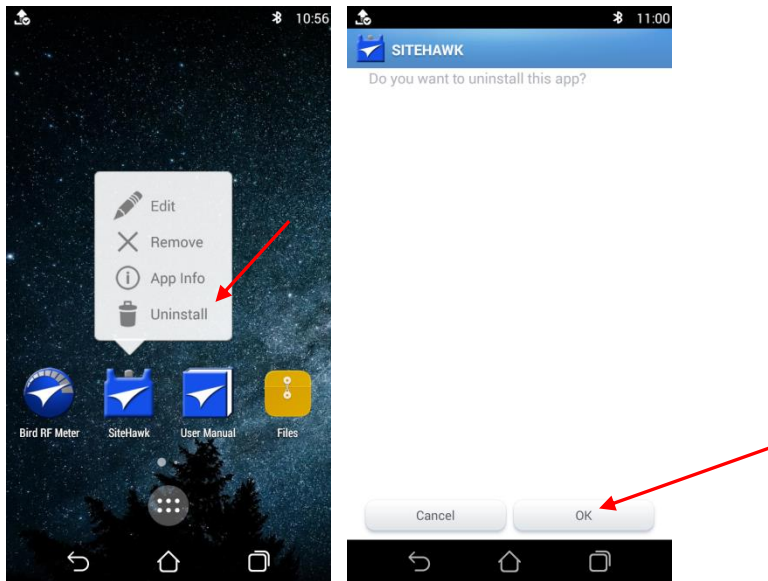
3. Create a backup folder. Press the + icon as shown in the 1st photo below. Enter the new backup folder name (SiteHawk_Backup) and press Save.



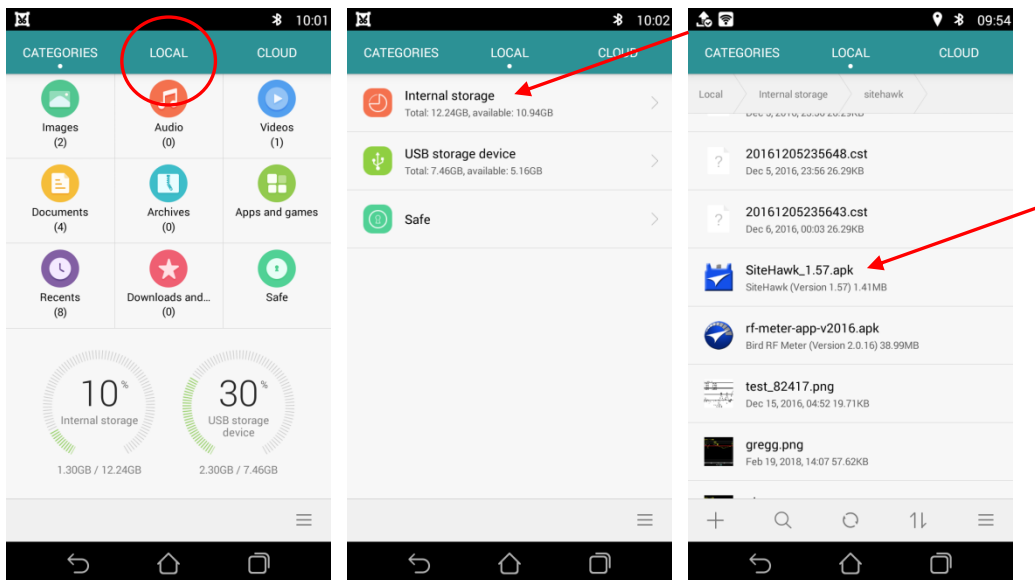
4. Copy all files you want to keep from the 'sitehawk' folder to the 'Sitehawk_Backup' folder.
5. Delete the 'sitehawk' folder and all files in it.
6. Uninstall the SiteHawk app. Navigate to main screen by pressing Home icon. Tap on the circle with the six dots. Press and hold SiteHawk icon until Edit, Remove, App Info, Uninstall drop box appears.



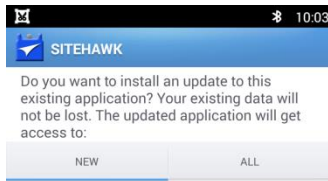
7. Select Uninstall. Press OK.



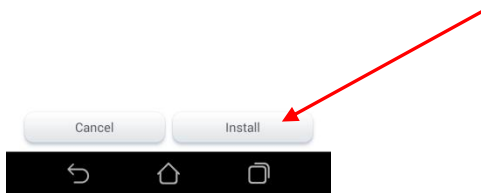
8. Navigate back to Local, Internal storage as from above. Find your latest SiteHawk_1.xx.apk file and Tap on it (should be siteHawk_1.57 or later).



9. Tap on Install and follow the prompts.



This update requires no new permissions.



10. Once installed, you may see the "Connecting" message on a blue screen. Let it run for about 15 seconds as it is creating files in the background. After about 15 seconds, power the unit down, wait about 5 seconds, then power it back up. It will probably display the "connecting" message again but should go away after about 5 seconds.
